



Ohio Constitutional Modernization Commission Holds Monthly Meetings

July 12, 2016

The Ohio Constitutional Modernization Commission will be holding meetings of select committees on Thursday, July 14, 2016. All meetings will be held at the Ohio Statehouse.

The **Bill of Rights and Voting Committee** will meet at 9:30 a.m. in Ohio Statehouse Room 017. The committee is scheduled to continue its review on [Article V, Section 1](#) of the Ohio Constitution, dealing with qualifications of an elector.

The **Judicial Branch and Administration of Justice Committee** will meet at 11:00 a.m. in Ohio Statehouse Room 018. The committee is scheduled to continue discussion on [Article I, Section 10](#) of the Ohio Constitution, dealing with grand juries.

The **Organization and Administration Committee** will meet at 12:30 p.m. in Ohio Statehouse Room 017. The committee is scheduled to discuss what changes, if any, it wishes to take to the Commission's Rules of Procedure and Conduct regarding quorums.

The **Legislative Branch and Executive Branch Committee** will meet at 1:30 p.m. in Ohio Statehouse Room 018. The committee is scheduled to hold discussion on sections in [Article II](#) of the Ohio Constitution, by topic, for the purpose of reviewing these provisions for further committee action.

About the Ohio Constitutional Modernization Commission

The OCMC was created in 2011 by the Ohio General Assembly in House Bill 188 of the 129th General Assembly. It is modeled after the Ohio Constitutional Revision Commission which completed its work in the 1970's.
