ANNOUNCEMENT OF COMMITTEE MEETING

The Ohio Constitutional Modernization Commission's Coordinating Committee will meet on Thursday, May 11, 2017 at 12:15 p.m. in Room 017 of the Ohio Statehouse.

The Coordinating Committee potentially will consider and <u>vote</u> on whether to approve a report and recommendation from the Bill of Rights and Voting Committee for no change to Article V, Section 2 (Election by Ballot); two reports and recommendations from the Education, Public Institutions, and Local Government Committee for change to Article VII, Sections 2 and 3 (Directors of Public Institutions) and Section 1 (Support for Persons with Certain Disabilities); a report and recommendation from the Judicial Branch and Administration of Justice Committee relating to the grand jury process in Article 1, Section 10; and a report and recommendation by the Constitutional Revision and Updating Committee relating to the initiative and referendum process contained in Article II. In addition, the committee will review and vote on its own report and recommendation relating to the use of gender-neutral language in the Ohio Constitution. The committee will review the reports and recommendations for style and completeness, and not as to content.
