Steve Steinglass presented comments on a conversation that he had with Greg Stype concerning obsolete provisions and comparative economic development the Coordinating Committee created a working group to address these issues).

Speaker Davidson suggested reaching out to the Treasurer's office regarding the sinking fund. Vice Chair Bell requested presentations from both the Treasurer's office and Greg Stype regarding the sinking fund, and Representative Amstutz suggested involving the Office of Budget Management in the discussion.

Vice Chair Bell requested the memo prepared by LSC regarding the provisions this committee wishes to address be circulated to the committee and be posted for public input.
