



OHIO CONSTITUTIONAL MODERNIZATION COMMISSION

ANNOUNCEMENT OF COMMISSION MEETING

The Ohio Constitutional Modernization Commission will meet on Thursday, May 11, 2017 at 1:00 p.m. in Room 313 of the Ohio Statehouse.

The full Commission will review up to six reports and recommendations on first presentation, with one report and recommendation for no change being subject to a potential vote.

A report and recommendation for no change to Article V, Section 2 is scheduled for consideration and adoption.

The reports and recommendations expected to have a first presentation are on changes to **Article VII, Section I** (Support for Persons with Certain Disabilities), **Article VII, Sections 2 and 3** (Directors of Public Institutions), **Article 1, Section 10** (Grand Jury), the **Initiative and Referendum sections of Article II**, and the use of **Gender Neutral Language** in the Ohio Constitution. Per the Commission's Rules of Procedure and Conduct, because these sections are being recommended for change, the Commission will need to have a second presentation at another meeting before a vote can occur.

The full Commission also may address matters related to Article V, Section 6 (Mental Capacity to Vote).
