



OHIO CONSTITUTIONAL MODERNIZATION COMMISSION

ANNOUNCEMENT OF COMMISSION MEETING

The Ohio Constitutional Modernization Commission will meet on Thursday, April 13, 2017 at 1:30 p.m. in Room 1960, 19th Floor of the Riffe Center for Government and the Arts.

Depending on the committee activities earlier in the day, the Commission will review up to two reports and recommendations on first presentation. The Commission also will vote on up to five reports and recommendations for no change. The reports and recommendations set for first presentation are on Article I, Section 8 (Writ of Habeas Corpus), for no change; and on Article I, Section 10 (The Grand Jury), for change. The report and recommendation regarding the grand jury will require a second presentation before a vote may be taken.

The Commission also will vote on whether to adopt up to five reports and recommendations: Article II, Sections 3, 4, 5, and 11 (Member Qualifications and Vacancies in the General Assembly), Article II, Sections 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, and 14 (Conducting Business of the General Assembly); Article II, Sections 10 and 12 (Rights and Privileges of Members of the General Assembly); Article V, Section 2a (Names of Candidates on Ballot); and Article I, Section 8 (Writ of Habeas Corpus).
